
<u>CANCELLATION</u>: No Cancelation penalties for land portion of the tour if made more than 90 days prior to departure.

TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1: Excited to leave for Israel knowing the long flight will be well worth it.

Day 2: Arrive at our layover stop and options to sight see a European city. Then we'll continue on our way to the Holy Land.

Day 3: We finally arrive at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv. As we board the bus, our guide welcomes us to Israel with a familiar word: Shalom. Our imagination doesn't do the Mediterranean justice—what a beautiful site! We should all rest well tonight.

Day 4: How lovely to wake up hearing waves lapping the shore of Tel Aviv! We drive along the Mediterranean coastline on our way to Caesarea to see the stately, ancient Roman amphitheater where Paul stood trial. Imagine the excitement of Cornelius, the first gentile of the Church Age to be saved, when he met Peter at this very place. Well see Meggido and see King Solomon's stables, MT Carmel where Elijiah called down fire and view the town of Nazareth where Jesus grew up before checking into our hotel on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5: We'll take time to offer up praise and worship while sailing on the Sea of Galilee. Then off to see a boat dating back to the time of Christ. Then off to Capernaum, Mt of Beatitudes and then the opportunity to be baptized in the Jordan River.

Day 6: We visit the ancient city of Dan at the heart of the Northern Kingdom of Israel. We visit Caesarea Philippi, Mt. Bental – Olive Tree Factory and Peace Vista View Point.

Day 7: We visit Drive southwards along the Jordan Valley to ancient Shiloh situated in the Benjamin Region. This is where the Ark of the Covenant was brought by the children of Israel and where it stood for 369 years.

Day 13: Today we head out to one of King Solomon's copper mines in Timna. While there we visit a replica of the Tabernacle that served the Children of Israel before the building of the Temple. We visit one of Abraham's wells that sits among the ancient ruins in Be'er Sheva, a town visited by Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

After dinner in Tel Aviv, we depart for the airport to head home, arriving in the evening in San Francisco or Fresno.
